THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. By 4:00 pm AEST on 14 September 2026, the applicant file and serve an application to amend the Originating Application, together with a proposed Statement of Claim and all affidavit material in support thereof to be relied upon at the hearing of the application.
2. By 4:00 pm AEST on 18 September 2026, the applicant file and serve any application for interim injunctive relief pursuant to section 234 of the *Australian Consumer Law*, together with all affidavit material in support thereof to be relied upon at the hearing of the application.
3. By 4:00 pm AEST on 25 September 2026, the respondent shall file and serve any application for security for costs of any application filed by the applicant for interim injunctive relief, together with all affidavits to be relied on at the hearing.
4. If the respondent files an application for security for costs by 4:00 pm AEST on 25 September 2026, then:
 - (a) by 4:00 pm AEST on 30 September 2026, the applicant shall file and serve any affidavits to be relied on at the hearing of the application for security for costs;
 - (b) by 4:00 pm AEST on 6 October 2026, the respondent shall file and serve on the applicant any affidavits in reply and a written outline of submissions in support of such application;
 - (c) by 4:00 pm AEST on 8 October 2026, the applicant shall file and serve on the respondent a written outline of submissions in respect of such application; and



- (d) the application shall be listed for hearing at 9:00 am AEST on 9 October 2026.
5. If the respondent does not file an application for security for costs by 4:00 pm AEST on 25 September 2026, then the matter be listed for a case management hearing at 9:00am on 9 October 2026.
 6. Liberty to apply.
 7. Costs reserved.
