## **Glenbog State Forest No 149 Compartments 2301, 2311, 2321**



4<sup>th</sup> July 2014, Injured (facial/head trauma) Bare-Nosed Wombat. Also suffering from early stages of *Sarcoptes* Scabies due to stress of logging activities and loss of his/her habitat. Found near Dump Point D.



26<sup>th</sup> June 2014, Wombat burrow number 389 - G S36°32'42.6 - E149°25'52.1 (Dump Point I) totalled to non-existence.



12<sup>th</sup> July and again 18<sup>th</sup> July 2014. Less than 5 meters from contractor's "lunch break" area was a well-marked burrow number 352 - GPS S36\*32'38.5 – E149\*25'40.9 Dump Point H. BACK FILLED AND BLOCKED **TWICE**.



4<sup>th</sup> July 2014, Burrow 444, GPS S36\*32'54.1 – E149\*25'34.9. Destroyed and unable to find entrance



26<sup>th</sup> July 2014, Burrow 351, GPS S36\*32'38.2 E149\*25'43.6 Dump point H. Clearly marked, fresh wombat foot prints leading into burrow. Totally backfilled, debris felled and pushed over burrow entrance.

27<sup>th</sup> July 2014, Burrow 390, GPS S36\*32'42.5- UNDER THE NEWLY MADE ROAD, burrow was





27<sup>th</sup> July 2014, Burrow 361, GPS S36\*32'40.3 – E149\*25,45.1, Boulders, rocks and soil pushed by dozer? and blocked entrance.



27<sup>th</sup> July 2014, Burrow 359, GPS S36\*32'40.7 – E149\*25'47.5. Trees and branches felled above burrow.



27<sup>th</sup> July 2014, Burrow 360, GPS S36\*32'40.8 – E149\*25'47.5, Trees and branches felled above burrow.



21<sup>st</sup> June 2014, Trees harvest and fallen branches within rocky outcrop. Between Dump point B and C.



26<sup>th</sup> June 2014, Empty oil drum found in branches of logging debris on Southern side of 2311/8 Rd towards Dump point A.



21<sup>st</sup> June 2014, Oil drums, oily rags, empty plastic yoghurt containers left on ground. Found on numerous locations throughout the Forest.



Referring to clause in Final Operational Plan  
**“HAULAGE TIMES**  
*Truck movements are restricted during the early morning and late afternoon. No haulage may occur in the morning before sunrise or from one hour prior to sunset”.*

6.10 am (before sunrise) Contractor entering harvest zone via Western end of Jumping Creek Fire Trail. At 5pm contractor with orange/red ute containing dog cage and **dog** exiting the same route.



2<sup>nd</sup> August 2014 Burrow 352 backfilled for the third time. Marker deliberately removed and tucked into nearby log at campsite.



8<sup>th</sup> August 2014, Burrow 397, Entrance blocked



8<sup>th</sup> August 2014, Burrow 398, Entrance blocked



8<sup>th</sup> August 2014, Wombat in saved burrow 398 suffering from early stages of Sarcoptes Scabies.



9<sup>th</sup> August 2014, Marker 387 deliberately torn off by hand
